New Bern ArtWorks & Company – upcoming Artwalk receptions:

April 20th - "Woven Narratives Exhibit" – A New Trans-Atlantic Collaborative Series of Works Printed on the iPad by Fabric Lenny & Johnathan Grauel. Most of the works presented in this exhibit were created and shared using only the iPad as a drawing and painting tool. Each of the works has travelled an average of 50,000 miles during its creation, bouncing back and forth via email or through the international postal system as its individual narrative unfolds. The result is an ongoing dialogue of signs, symbols, image making and colour, a series of 'Woven Narratives', which engage the viewer in a 'mesh' of images and marks which share collective stories and experiences.

May 11th - Featured exhibit by artist Bruce Nellsmith – Bruce starts with nature (a cityscape, a port, or even the memory of a place that he has visited) and then adjusts or sometimes almost destroys that objective image in order to resurrect an essentially abstract vocabulary of line, color, and shape capable of carrying the more subjective feelings that he attaches to a place or a memory.

June 8th - An Alphabetical Tribute - Conie Minneci's series A-Z Women Artists, compelling in both its artistry and concept, fits squarely in a movement in recent decades to research and represent the contributions of women artists. This exhibit provides viewers with an opportunity to discover several relatively obscure artist-women who remained unknown. Outdoor Recreation

Boating, fishing, paddling, hunting, golfing, biking, hiking, bird watching, photography, camping, and tennis are only a few of many outdoor recreation opportunities in New Bern!

Nestled between the Neuse and Trent Rivers in Eastern North Carolina, New Bern is a haven for boaters, fishermen, and water sport fanatics. You can choose from small tributaries and creeks to the mile wide Neuse River. The New Bern area hosts big yachts to small watercraft. From large Marina's to off the path boat ramps, you'll find them here. To locate area boat access ramps, visit www.ncwildlife.org.

Fishing is plentiful! Some of the water is brackish so you can catch both salt water and fresh water fish. Stop into our local Sportsman's Toy Store to get the inside scoop (638-5600). For a unique outdoor experience, call Four Seasons Guide Service (638-6797), Spec Fever Fishing Guide Services (249-1520), or Speckrigg Charters Guide Services (637-6908). Custom Marine Inc, 2401 Hwy 70 E (638-5422) also has boating and fishing equipment. Contact the Neuse Riverkeepers (637-7972) for paddle trail maps and details about boating and fishing on the Neuse and Trent Rivers along with their tributaries. Fishing in both fresh and salt water - you need both licenses.

A "Nature Lover's Paradise", enjoy a "walk in the woods" in the Croatan National Forest. The forest's habitat supplies excellent conditions for exotic plants like the Venus flytrap, making it the only National Forest with the largest carnivorous plant population. The Croatan spans approximately 160,000 acres and is located in New Bern's backyard. It provides a sanctuary to the black bear, deer, wild turkey, quail, coyote, beaver, porcupine, bobcat, American alligator, bald eagle, pileated woodpecker, red-tailed hawk, are among some of the wildlife you may see.

Talk to the trained volunteers or rangers at the Croatan National Forest Ranger's Station on Hwy 70 E (638-5628) for more information. I consider the Croatan as a **Natural Wonder of Eastern North Carolina**. It's full of history and the untamed lands are a special place where wildlife and flora flourish! There are also walking trails throughout our City and County. Contact New Bern Parks & Recreation (639-2912) and/or Craven County Recreation & Parks (636-6606). The new "Riverwalk" begins at Union Point Park.

Join other cyclists at <u>Flythe's Bike Shop</u>, 2411 Trent Rd, as Flythe's leads bike rides around town (638-1544). You can also rent bike's from them or Galley Stores, 300 E. Front St. <u>Atomic Cycles</u> also leads rides around town. Visit them at 504 S. Front St. or call them to find out more information about their rides or bike rentals (633-2242).

Attention golf lovers! Visit Carolina Colours Golf Course (772-7022), Carolina Pines Golf & Country Club (444-1000), the Emerald Golf Club (633-4440), New Bern Golf and Country Club (637-4061), Taberna Country Club (634-1600), River Bend Golf & Country Club (638-2819), or the Cherry Point Golf Course on MCAB (466-3044).

Campers have many choices. You can stay in New Bern's luxury campground - KOA, located on Hwy 17 N in Bridgeton (800-562-3341). If you prefer a smaller scale campground, visit Flanner's Beach Campground or Neuse River Campground which are run by the Croatan National Forest. Brice's Creek Boat ramp also has a small primitive campground. Call the National Forest Service (252-638-5628) for more information.

Prefer tennis? There are tennis courts throughout New Bern including Craven Community College, New Bern Golf and Country Club (637-4061), The Emerald Country Club (633-4440), Harbour Town Racquet Club (636-5652), New Bern Parks and Recreational facilities (639-2912), and Craven County Recreation and Parks (636-6606).

Fishing Report for New Bern area: Striped bass will be returning down river towards New Bern post spawn and the fishing can be amazing! Look for great early and late top water fishing along the shorelines and bridges. Spotted seatrout have been plentiful this spring so look for specks in the creeks and river shorelines just down river of New Bern. Fresh water fishing can also be very good with bass, bream, crappie and catfish on the Trent, Brice's Creek and the Neuse up river of New Bern. - Captain Gary Dubiel of Spec Fever Guide Services (249-1520).




